



HANDING OVER OF A HOUSE FOR DISABLED FAMILY IN FRANKFORT, 03 DECEMBER 2014



In acknowledgement of Disability Day 02 December 2014 as part of the 16 days of Activism Campaign for no Violence Against Women and Children, the Department of Human Settlements in conjunction with the Department of Social Development will hand over a specially constructed house to a family of disabled persons in Frankfort tomorrow afternoon. The event will be led by the Minister for the Department of Social Development and takes place within the context of the DISABILITY DAY EVENT as per attached programme.

The Acting MEC for Cooperative Governance, Traditional Affairs and Human Settlements, MEC for Social Development MEC Sisi Ntombela together with the Minister for Social Development Minister Bathabile Dlamini, will hand over this family home to Mr Mosiya, a wheelchair based elderly gentleman who lives with his sister who walks on crutches.

The exclusive, face brick and tiled disability compliant 62m² house worth over R100 000 was built by Thutela Bogolo CC, one of the winners of the National 2012 Govan Mbeki Awards. The award included a R100 000 prize meant for social responsibility, particularly construction of a house in an area that the company had been working in i.e. built government subsidised houses.
